

# Clipper Blade Conversion Chart

Barber/beauty to Pet grooming Sizes  
from Tim Love

Barber blades tend to cut one size shorter than the number they cross over too. This is due to some of the combs in certain sizes being thinner than the pet grooming blades.

<u>Pet Grooming Size</u>	<u>Barber/Beauty Size</u>
<b>#10</b>	<b>#0</b>
<b>#15</b>	<b>#0A</b>
<b>#30</b>	<b>#000</b> (Cuts like a 40)
<b>#40</b>	<b>#0000</b> (Cuts like a 50)
<b>#50</b>	<b>#00000</b> (This is used for smooth skin shaves)
<b>#9</b>	<b>#1A</b>
<b>#8 1/2</b>	<b>#1</b>
<b>#7F</b>	<b>#1 1/2</b>
<b>#5F</b>	<b>#2</b>
<b>#4F</b>	<b>#3 1/2</b>

There are no "Skip-tooth" blades with the Barber/Beauty blades, and your guard combs should fit. Try them on first.
